

Betty A. (Hockenbroch) Willow, (2 Aug 1919 – 27 Jul 2011), The Perry County Times, Saturday, August 6, 2011

Betty A. Willow, 91, of New Bloomfield and formerly of Millerstown, died Wednesday, July 27, 2011 at The Manor at Perry Village, New Bloomfield, where she had resided since 2004.

She was born Aug. 2, 1919 at home in Susquehanna Twp., Juniata County, rural Liverpool, to **Maynard** and **Verna (Frymoyer) Hockenbroch**.

She was a member of the former St. James Evangelical United Brethren Church, Liverpool; educated at Union Grammar School; and enjoyed gardening, especially flower gardening, and crocheting.
