

James R. Wilson, (2 Jul 1866 – 2 Aug 1935), Duncannon Record, Thursday, August 29, 1935

James R. Wilson, President of the Bank of Landisburg, and trustee of the Carlisle Hospital, died at his home, Landisburg, Thursday morning following a protracted illness, having been confined to bed for the last month.

Deceased was instrumental in the organization of the Bank of Landisburg in 1903 and served as its cashier since 1904. About a year ago he resigned to become president of the institution. Before entering the banking business **Wilson** conducted a butcher shop at Landisburg.

In addition to his widow he is survived by a son, **John Wilson**, of Oakmont and a granddaughter.

Funeral services were conducted at his late home Saturday afternoon and the remains interred in the Cemetery at Centre.
