

**John W. Wilson**, (Died Sep 1918), Patriot, Friday, July 29, 1921; Veterans to Conduct Two Military Funerals

Carlisle posts of the American Legion and the Veterans of Foreign Wars assisted by units of the National Guard and the Army Post Band will conduct funeral services for the bodies of two Carlisle veterans of the World War which arrived from overseas Wednesday night.

Funeral services for **Private Charles A. Rynard**, son of **Mr. and Mrs. John Rynard**, West North Street, will be held tomorrow afternoon at 2 o'clock in St. Paul's Lutheran Church. Burial will be in the Prospect Hill Cemetery, Newville. He died in France of "flu" in March, 1919. He was a member of the 103<sup>rd</sup> Engineers.

Funeral services for **Private John W. Wilson** will be held Sunday afternoon at 1 o'clock in the home of his aunt, **Mrs. Sarah Shatto**, North and Bedford Streets. Burial will be in the Shermansdale Cemetery. He was a member of the 112<sup>th</sup> Infantry and was killed in action in the Argonne in September, 1918.

Word has also been received of the arrival in New York of the body of **Private Paul W. Kelly**, son of **George Kelly**, of F. Streets
