

Philip Winterod, Patriot, Tuesday, 31 July 1883, Winterod's Death.

A gentleman residing in Duncannon gives some additional particulars about Philip Winterod, who was struck by a train at Duncannon and died in the hospital in this city. He states that Winterod lived near Lewistown, was a brother-in-law of **Lewis B. Lewis**, formerly of Duncannon and now of Kansas. The deceased man he says, worked for John McNeal near Losh's Run and before his death he stated that McNeal owed him seventeen dollars for seventeen days work at haymaking and harvesting. The gentleman also says that Winterod was perfectly sober at the time of his death as he had seen him shortly before his store in Duncannon, where he bought one of the knives found on his person. The money due the deceased man can be obtained by going to McNeal. Winterod's wife died last year. He had one child which was with his sister in Harrisburg.
