

Mary Elizabeth (Apple) Wise, (10 Feb 1793 – 4 Jun 1870), Newport News, May 21, 1870

Painful Accident – We learn that a **Mrs. Wise**, an elderly lady residing with **Mr. Cyrus Clemson**, of Tuscarora Township, met with a painful accident on Wednesday of last week. It appears that she had not had the use of her limbs for some time; having had a stroke of paralysis. She was addicted to smoking and on the day named was indulging in her favorite pastime, when by some means her clothes took fire, and being unable to make a noise, she was severely burned in her person before the occupants of the house were aware of her misfortune. It is said that the nails of some of her fingers are burned off. Medical aid was immediately summoned.
