

Harriet M. Zeigler (1854 – 1933), Unknown Newspaper

Mrs. **Harriet Zeigler** aged 79 years, 9 months and 4 days died Thursday evening in a Harrisburg Hospital where she had been since the Tuesday evening previous. Mrs. Zeigler's death was the result of a fall down 15 steps, and sustained fractures of several ribs, skull and hand.

Mrs. Zeigler was a native of Black Log, Huntingdon County but came here as a child where she resided continuously until six years ago when she removed to Harrisburg. She was the last of her family but is survived by the following children: **Mrs. J. C. Ernest**, **Mrs. Catherine Barron**, **Miss Rebecca Zeigler** and **Warren B. Zeigler**, Harrisburg and **Mrs. C. L. Bair**, Newport. There are surviving ten grandchildren and four great-grandchildren.

Funeral services were Sunday afternoon at the L. M. Kell Funeral Home, with Rev. W. D. Mehrling officiating, Mrs. Zeigler being a member of the Newport Reformed church. The pallbearers were A. L. Gelnett, I. M. Meminger, Chas. E. Smith J. Austin Smith, C. C. Brandt, and Clarence S. Smith.

Interment was in Newport Cemetery.
