

Henry S. Zeigler, (1836 – 8 May 1901), Newport News, Thursday, May 9, 1901

Henry S. Zeigler died of paralysis yesterday at 4:15 a.m., at the home of his son **C. Zeigler**, in Harrisburg. While employed as a Pennsylvania Railroad trackman here in October, 1889, he was stricken with paralysis and had been an invalid since. Four weeks ago he was again stricken.

He was born near Milford, Juniata Township, and was married about 45 years ago to **Miss Annie Super**, who with the following five sons survive him: **Charles C.**; **George C.**, **A.W.** and **John M.**, all of Harrisburg, and **Samuel**, of this place.(Newport); He has one brother, **Amos**, of Greenburg, Clinton County, Pa.

The body of Mr. Zeigler will be brought to this place Saturday at 9:00 a.m. on Way Passenger, and interred in the Newport cemetery directly from the train.
