

**Samuel Robert Zeigler**, (1857 – 1941), Newspaper Clipping, Perry Historians

February 19, 1941 - **Samuel Robert Ziegler**

He was the oldest son of **Henry S.** and **Anna E. (Super) Zeigler** of Perry County. Mr. Zeigler was first married to **Lydia Catharine Tibbens** who died November 7, 1892. To this union five daughters were born, four of who survive, **Mrs. E. M. (Lillie) Skillman**, Roaring Springs; **Mrs. H. O. (Edna) Hartzel**, Harrisburg; **Mrs. E. M. (Myrtle) Buffington**, Lewistown; and **Mrs. Roy (Faye) Butler**, Roaring Springs. **Miss Hester E. Zeigler** died November 22, 1905. Three grandchildren survive. He is also survived by two brothers, **John Zeigler** and **Charles Zeigler** both of Harrisburg. Two brothers, **George** and **Amos**, having preceded him in death.

Mr. Zeigler's second marriage was to **Mrs. Ida L. Kines**, who died March 1, 1926. Following her death Mr. Zeigler moved from Newport, to Harrisburg, where he has since resided.

Previous to his removal to Harrisburg, Mr. Zeigler, with the exception of a few years spent in Illinois as a young man; continually resided in Newport and vicinity, having for years lived in what is known as Clemson.
