

Alvin O. Zerfing, (Died 24 Jul 1942), The Star and Sentinel, Saturday, July 25, 1942, Gettysburg, PA

A. O. Zerfing, 70, father of **George M. Zerfing**, Howard Avenue, died Friday evening at his home 8 South Market Square, Duncannon, from uremic poisoning. He became seriously ill last March and suffered a heart attack on Memorial Day.

From 1917 to 1927 the deceased was associated with his son, **George M.**, in the hardware business in Duncannon, and from 1927 until the present was associated with another son, **Carl H.**, in a similar business at Duncannon. **Mr. Zerfing** was manager of the Duncannon Iron Company from 1900 to 1917. He was prominent in civic affairs in Duncannon and was president of the town council. He was a lifelong member of the Presbyterian Church.

Surviving are his widow, the former **Annie V. Morris**; four children. **Mrs. Henry Barton**, Duncannon, **George M.**, Gettysburg; **Carl H.** Duncannon, and **Miss Marjorie A.**, York; one sister, **Ida Zerfing**, Duncannon, and one granddaughter, **Janet Louise Zerfing**, Gettysburg.

Funeral services Tuesday morning at 10:30 o'clock from the late home conducted by the **Rev. M. Billman**, pastor of the Fourth Congregational Reformed Church, Harrisburg, and a first cousin of the deceased, and the Rev. R. L. Rowe, pastor of the Duncannon Presbyterian Church. Interment in Duncannon.
