Charles F. Zimmerman, son of **Lucian C. and Clara R. (Steele) Zimmerman**, was born in Allen's Cove, Penn Township, June 21, 1878. He attended the Duncannon public schools. From 1895 to 1898 he attended Lafayette College. He then transferred to Princeton University, graduating in 1900, the next year taking a postgraduate course there. He was then with the First National Bank at Harrisburg as correspondence clerk for a time. When the Steelton Trust Company was organized in 1902 he was tendered a position there, and in 1906 became its treasurer. In 1912 he was elected treasurer of the Lebanon County Trust Company at Lebanon, Pennsylvania. He was chairman of Group Five of the Pennsylvania Bankers' Association, 1919-1921, and in 1921 was elected secretary of the State Bankers' Association. He is also chairman of the committee on education.
