**Dr. G. L. Zimmerman** was born in Madison Township, January 9, 1862, the son of **William** and **Margaret (Bower) Zimmerman**. He attended the public schools, Captain G. C. Palm's select school at Blain, Susquehanna University (then Missionary Institute) at Selinsgrove for three years, ending in 1886. He graduated in medicine at Jefferson Medical College in 1889 and located at Carlisle, where he has since practiced. He is a member of the staff of the Carlisle Hospital in the Department of Obstetrics. From 1904 to 1907 he was medical superintendent of the Cumberland County Hospital for Insane.
