

**Anna M. (Hight) Zinn**, (21 Dec 1844 – 26 Mar 1909), Newspaper Clipping, Perry Historinas

**Mrs. Anna Zinn**, relict of the late **George W. Zinn**, Esq, of Newport, died suddenly at the home of **John J. Troup** of Centre Township. on the 26th of March, in her 65th year, from heart failure.

Some weeks ago **Mrs. Zinn** while on a visit to **Mr.** and **Mrs. Troup**, dislocated her ankle and was just beginning to move freely about in the house when she was seized by heart with heart trouble. Her host and hostess had just started for Newport when **Mrs. Zinn** was stricken and died in a few minutes. Mrs. Cora Troup, a niece of **Mr. Troup**, was alone with her when she was overcome.

The deceased was born at Huntington, December 21, 1844, and married **George W. Zinn** in 1866. **Mr. Zinn** died January 13, 1900.

One daughter survives from this union, **Mrs. John Vaughn**, of Harrisburg. She was a consistent member of the M.E. Church. Interment on the 29th at Newport Cemetery.
