Ruth Marjorie Zorger, 93, of Cumberland Crossings Retirement Community, Carlisle, died Wednesday, Dec. 23, 2009 in Carlisle Regional Medical Center.

She taught at Pine Hill Elementary School, a one-room schoolhouse in Perry County, and later taught third grades at Vernon, Lincoln and Woodward schools in the Harrisburg School District; was a graduate of Shippensburg State Teachers College; a longtime member of First Church of God, Harrisburg, where she taught Sunday school for many years; and had a talent for sewing, quilting and cooking.

She was the widow of **George Zorger**, who died in December 2001 and to whom she was married 61 years.
